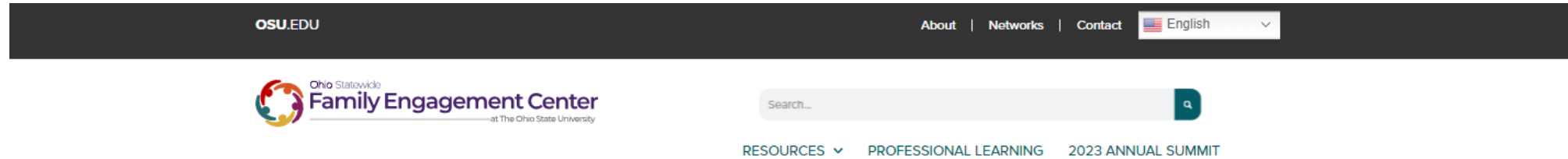

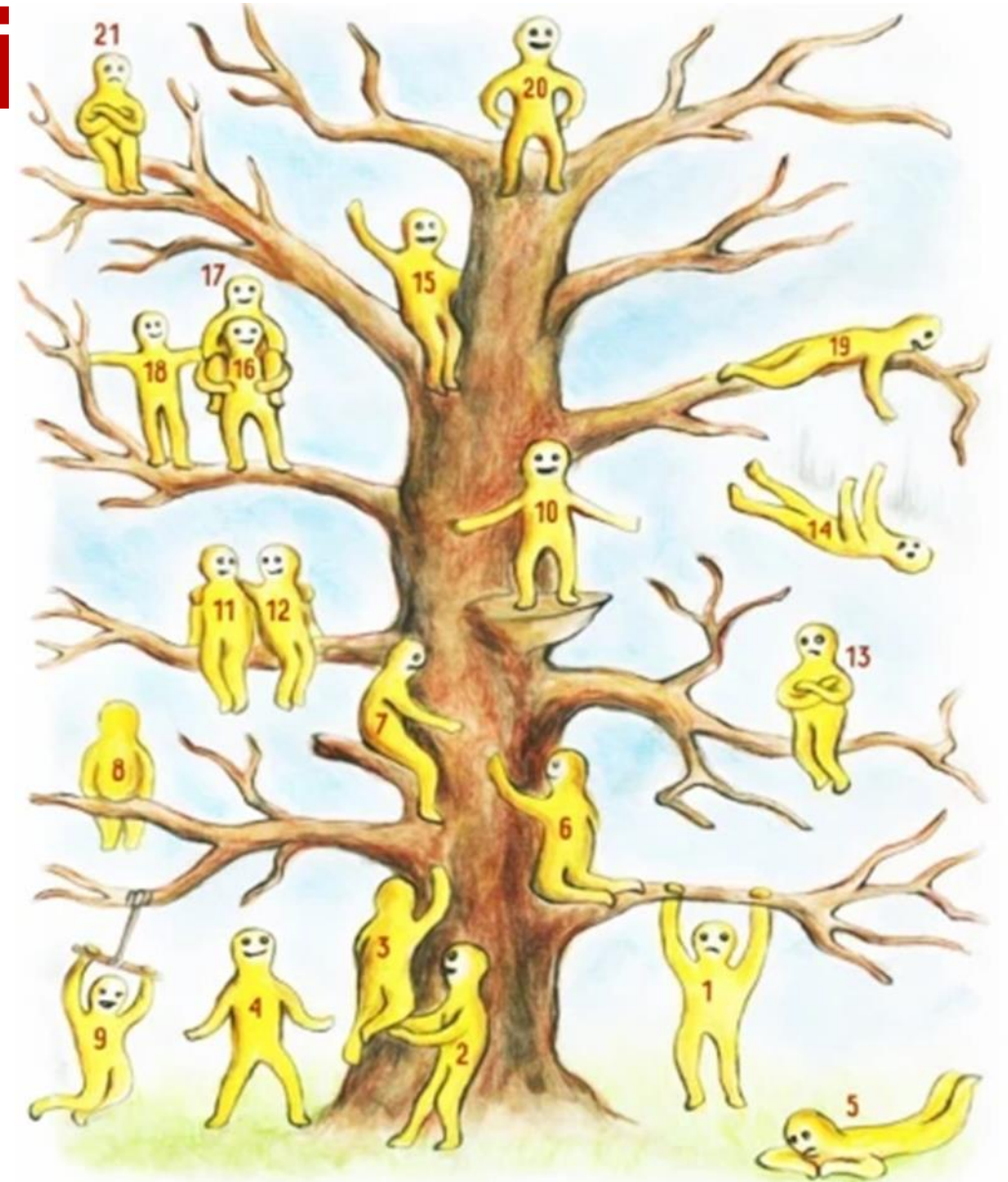

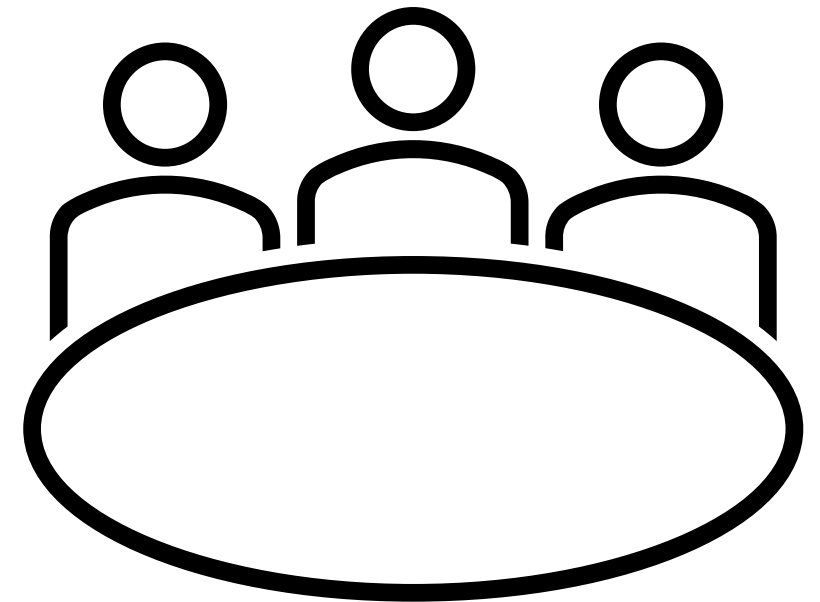

# Four “A”s Protocol



How Long?	Who is Speaking?	What to Share?
7 minutes	Each person, one at time	What <b>Assumptions</b> does the author hold?
7 minutes	Each person, one at time	What do you <b>Agree</b> with in the text?
7 minutes	Each person, one at time	What do you want to <b>Argue</b> with in the text?
7 minutes	Each person, one at time	What parts of the text do you want to <b>Aspire</b> to?
5 minutes	Open discussion	What does this mean for our work with families and students?
