Partnering with Families to Support Early Literacy is a self-paced, online course for teachers from grades Pre-K through 3rd grade to build their knowledge and skills for enhancing literacy instruction through family engagement. The course is divided into three modules: Partnering with Families, Home-based Practices to Support Early Literacy, and Communicating with Families about Early Literacy. To maximize the learning experience, we encourage teachers to take the course at the same time as their colleagues. This will provide for discussion and application as a team. Teachers may opt to participate in the course on their own, and individually commit to reflecting, sharing, and practicing the concepts presented in the course.

Full completion of the course modules is required to progress through the course and receive a certificate of completion.
