- Align to one or more of the Leadership and Facilitation Strategies (pages 261-277).
- · Connect with the DLT and/or BLT
- Include expected outcomes and success criteria or evidence of impact.
- · Demonstrate a plan for sustainability
- Address participation of families of students with disabilities, minority groups, EL, or others.
- Report to OSU (a least quarterly)

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


