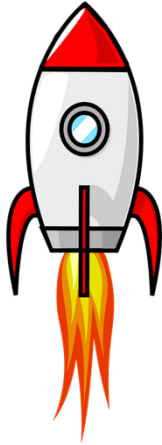

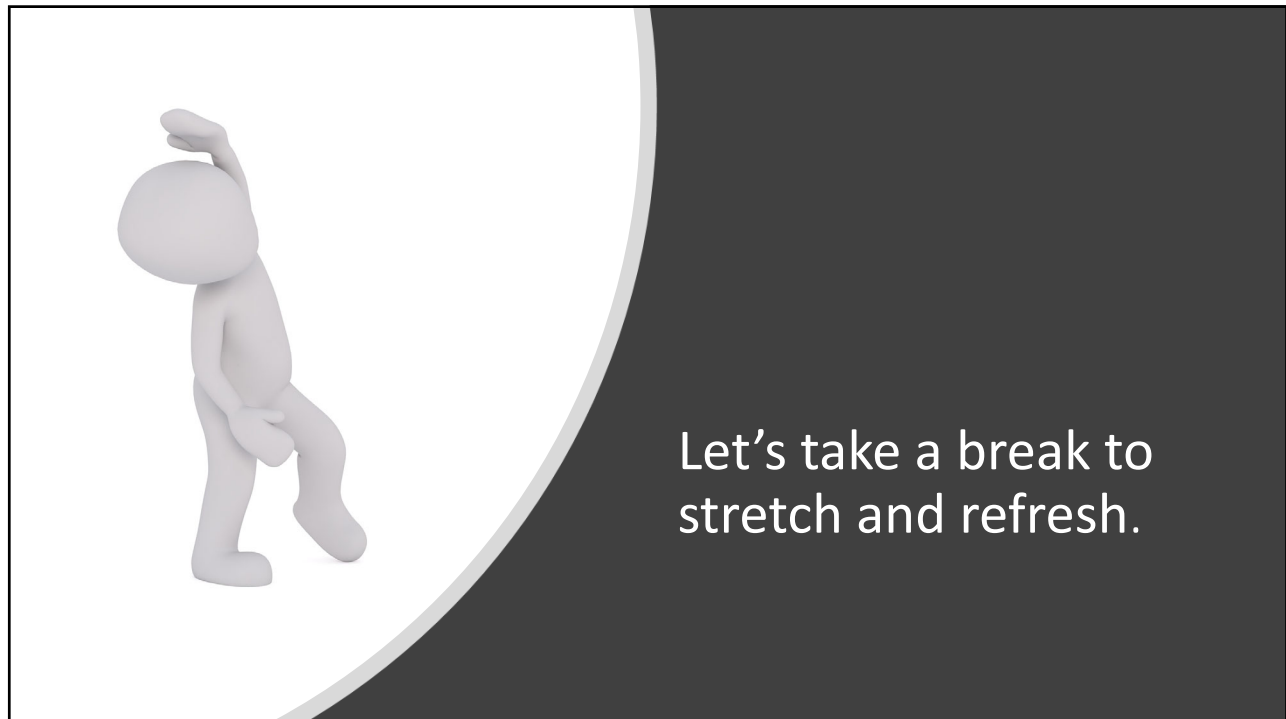

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## Priority 2: Advancing Family Engagement Regional Plan

- Period: October 2020- September 2021
- Due: October 15, 2020
- Prioritize training, TA, and/or resources to support high impact family engagement to...
- LEAs in Moderate or Intensive district support categories
- Build the capacity of school leaders, teachers, and families
- Align to one or more of the Leadership and Facilitation Strategies (pages 261-277).
- Connect with the DLT and/or BLT
- Include expected outcomes and success criteria or evidence of impact.
- Demonstrate a plan for sustainability
- Address participation of families of students with disabilities, minority groups, EL, or others.
- Report to OSU (a least quarterly)

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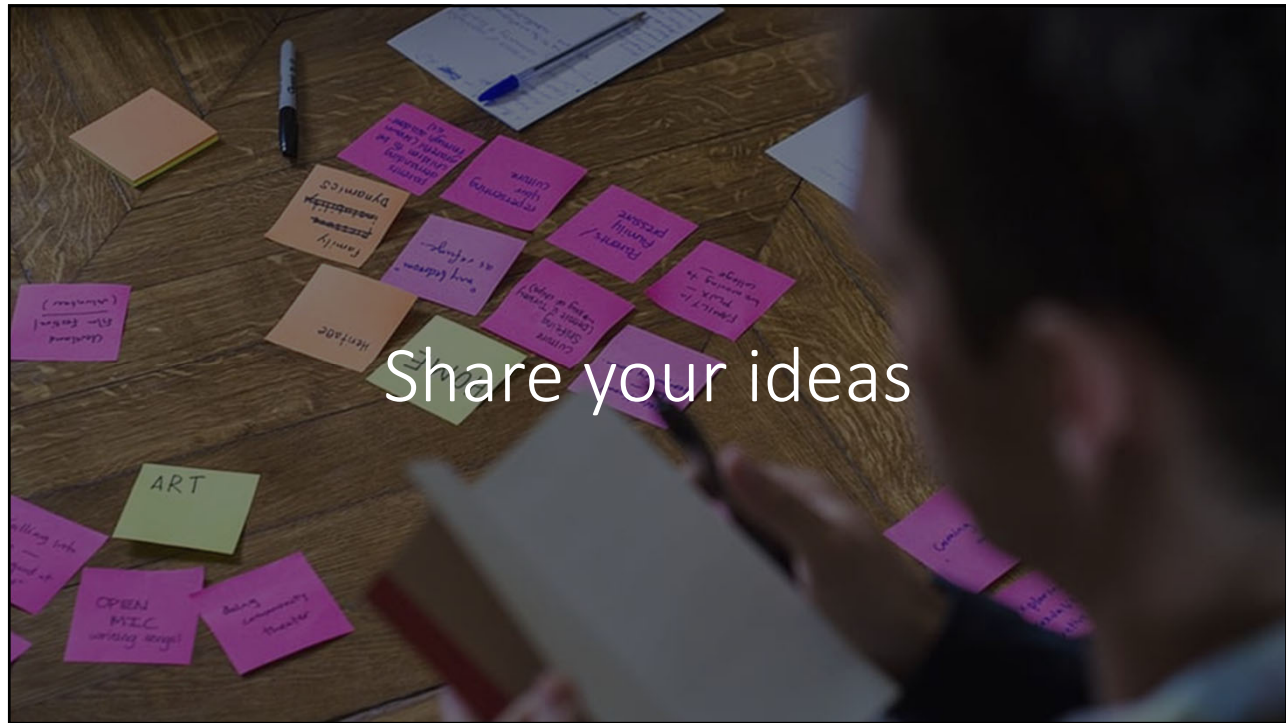

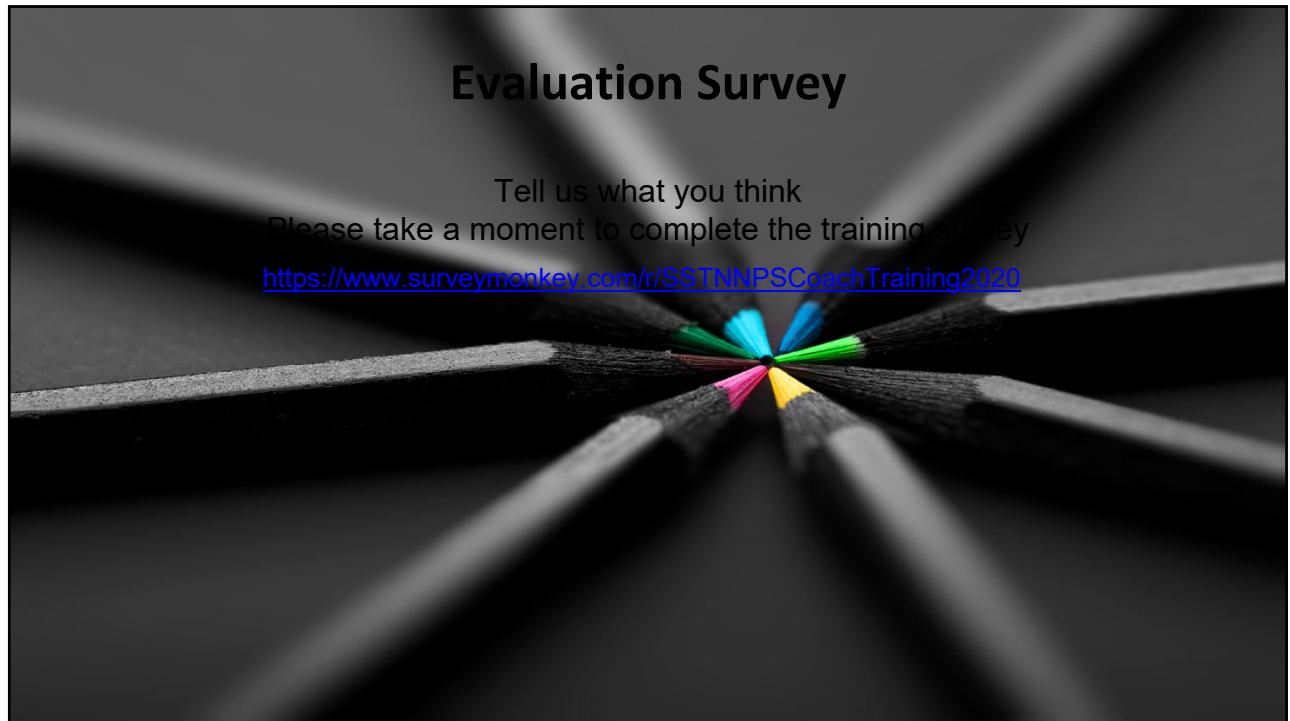
