Successes

Teachers are connecting the skills that they learned in their Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling training to the lessons that they are providing in their classrooms. Teachers are continuing to work to complete their Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling modules during this year of flexibility and transition. The Columbiana County Educational Service Center literacy coach has been working with teachers in modeling lessons with the students and has created videos that teachers can use for intervention or enrichment in class or while students are at home. Literacy coaches and teachers have formed relationships of trust and co-collaboration. The Columbiana County ESC has worked with State Support Team 5 for the past three years in providing a Regional Literacy Network and professional development for districts in Columbiana County.
