### Successes

Our greatest success thus far with the State Personnel Development Grant-funded activities is the value our parents bring to the discussions and decisions made to foster partnerships with our two schools and families. Over time, the Partnerships for Literacy teachers and administrators have relinquished more control and relied on our parent team members for the unique/fresh perspective on issues discussed and decisions that have been made. Secondly, as part of our planned activities, teachers have created online learning modules via slide decks to support families with literacy and learning. The Partnerships for Literacy team's review process of these slide deck has helped to improve how teachers communicate with family members.

### Sustainability

The potential impact is huge! We chose to focus on a few families to engage in our pilot online learning modules in exchange for their feedback to improve modules to make available to all district families during the 2021-2022 school year. Family members have been assigned Partnerships for Literacy coaches to dialogue and for receiving feedback as they interact with each learning module. Any administrator or teacher will have available all nine learning modules to use as needed to support families.
