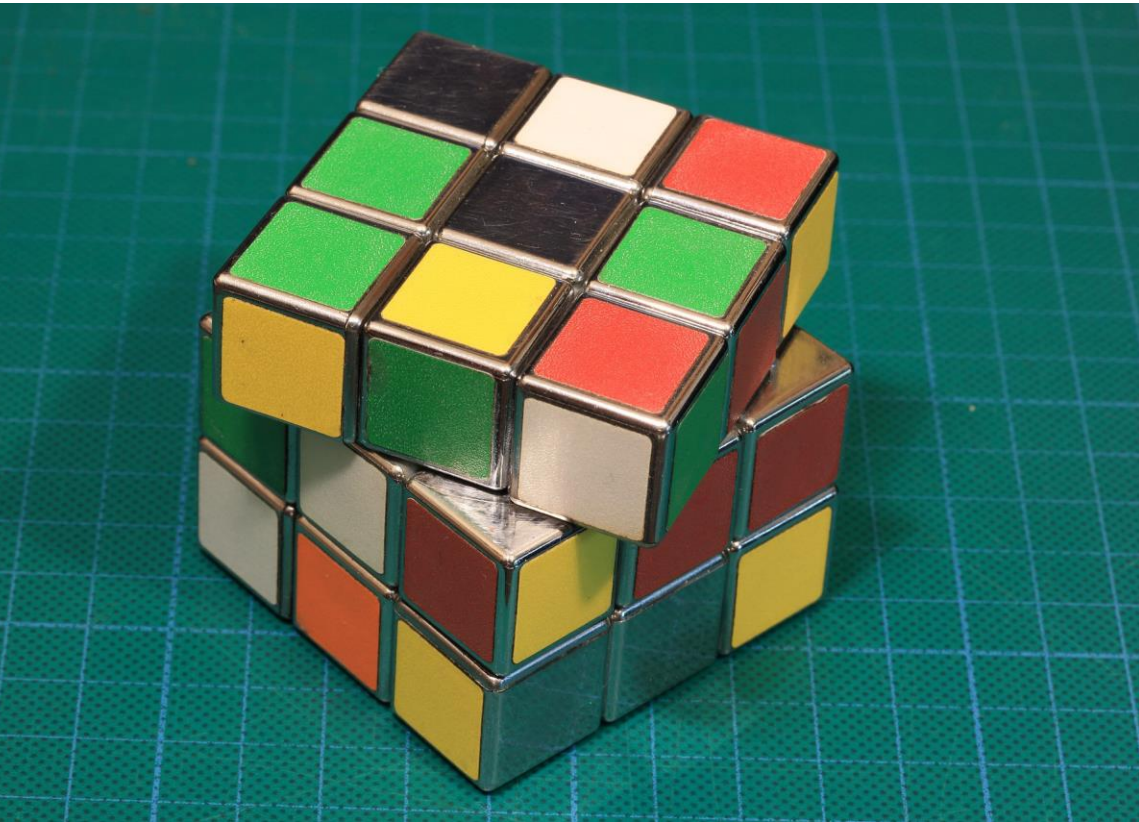


District Leadership Roles

Adapted from the Joyce Epstein's *School, Family, and Community Partnerships, Fourth Edition*

- Write a policy
- Assign a leader for partnerships
- Write a leadership plan for partnerships
- Identify a budget with adequate funds
- Guide each school to form an Action Team for Partnerships or a similar school committee on strengthening family-school-community partnerships
- Provide professional learning opportunities
- Conduct an end-of-year celebration
- Develop or select tools and resources
- Establish a district website
- Partner with businesses and community organizations
- Support research and evaluation

Problems of Practice

A problem of practice is an area that a school or school district identifies that is directly observable, is actionable, and connects to a broader strategy of improvement.

Using the Consultancy Protocol

- Step 1: Present the Problem of Practice
- Step 2: Ask Clarifying Questions
- Step 3: Ask Probing Questions
- Step 4: Discussion of the Problem
- Step 5: Debrief
