





#### **Regional Data Discussion Protocol**

Phases	Who is speaking?	Actions
Step 1: Share your data (5 mins for each person) 20 min	<ul> <li>Each member shares the data they brought.</li> <li>Share what the data is, why you brought it and what priorities you have for your region.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Other members listen and note any commonalities or any clarifications.</li> </ul>
Step 2: Data discussion 10 min.	<ul> <li>Discuss common concerns and priorities.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>One person of the group records and prepares to share out common concerns and priorities.</li> </ul>


