

Phases	Who is speaking?	Actions
Step 1: Share your data (5 mins for each person) 20 min	 Each member shares the data they brought. Share what the data is, why you brought it and what priorities you have for your region. 	 Other members listen and note any commonalities or any clarifications.
Step 2: Data discussion 10 min.	 Discuss common concerns and priorities. 	 One person of the group records and prepares to share out common concerns and priorities.
