Reframing Academy

The Reframing Academy is a seminar for family engagement leaders who want to learn more effective ways to build support for family and community engagement. How? Through proven communication and messages we can all use! The seminar will be delivered in 3 learning blocks through a flipped instructional model. For each block, participants will first individually complete a set of online modules to build their background knowledge. Then, participants will join a synchronous online community of practice session to apply their knowledge in professional contexts. The process will repeat for the next two learning blocks. The Reframing Academy was specifically designed for the Ohio Statewide Family Engagement Center by National Association for Family, School and Community Engagement (NAFSCE).

A certificate of completion will be given after each completed learning block (module and community of practice).
