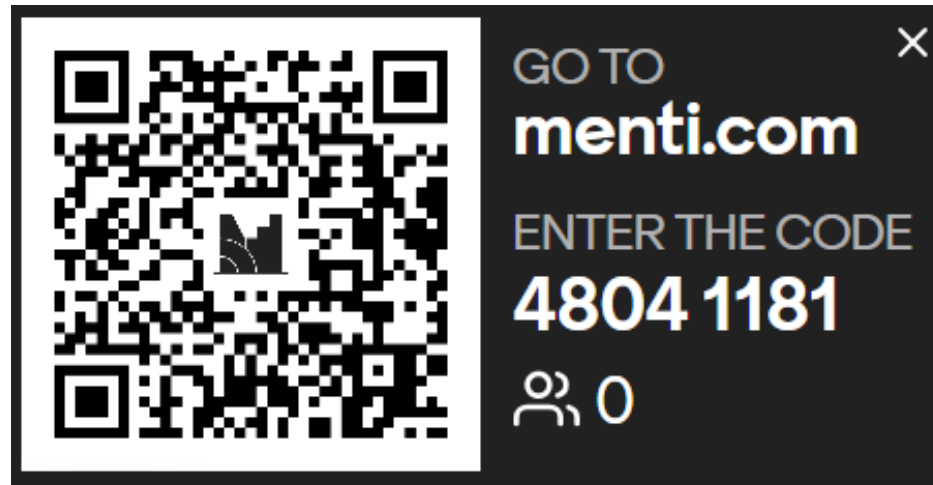

- 💡 **Receivers** of supports: e.g., assistance in completing forms
- 💡 **Initiators**: e.g., suggesting ideas to the school program
- 💡 **Co-Designers**: e.g., serving on leadership teams
- 💡 **Evaluators**: e.g., providing feedback through surveys

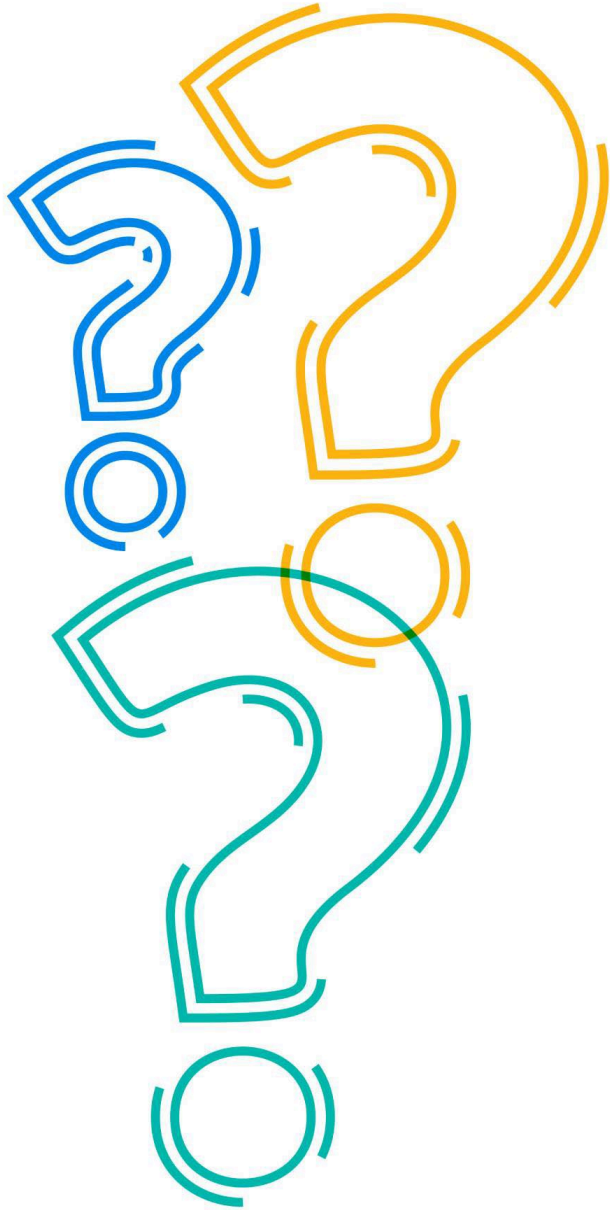

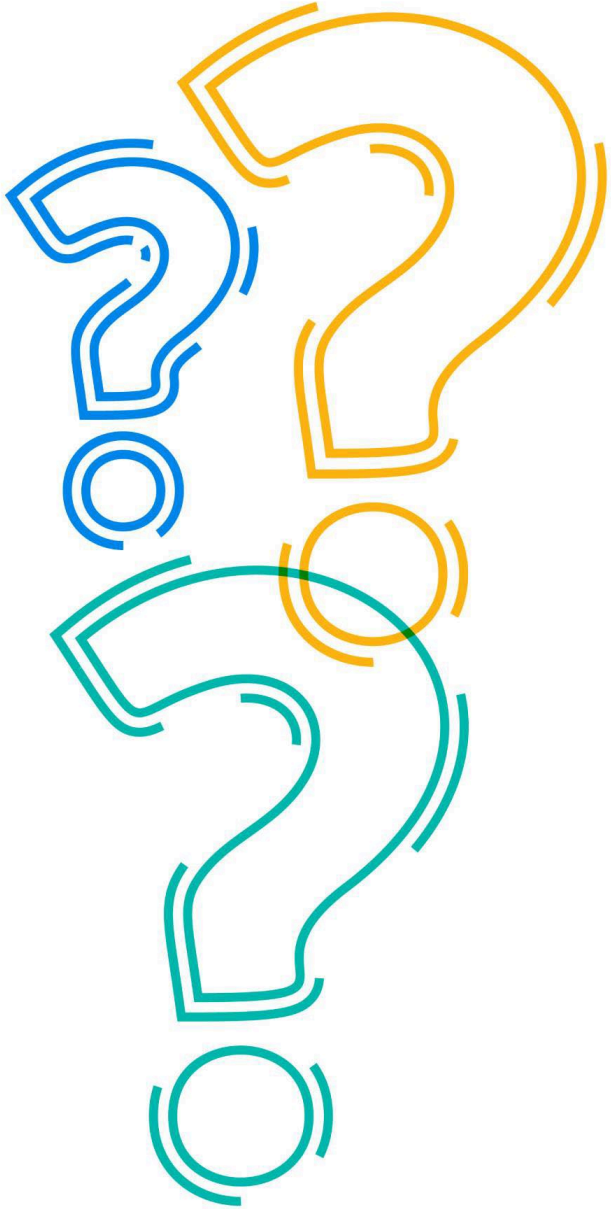

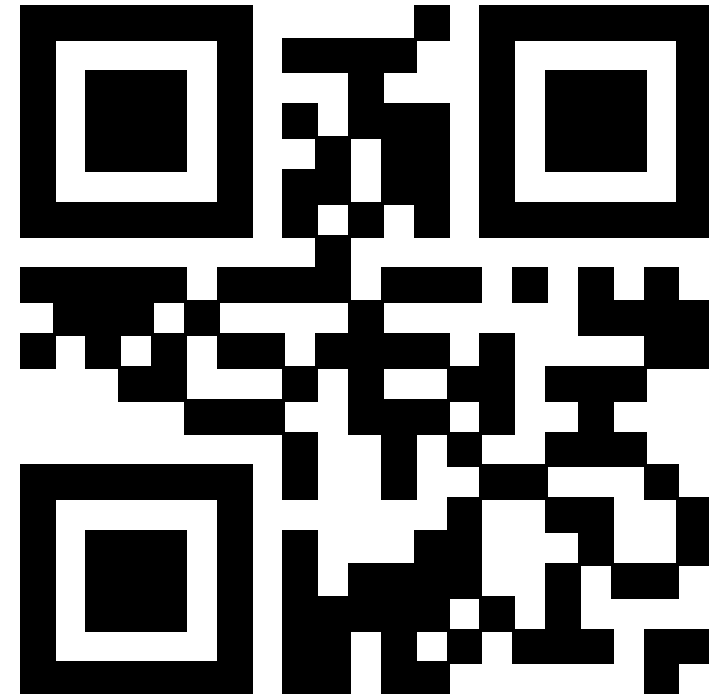
