Tier 1 Dyslexia Screener for Grades 1-6. By family request, or teacher request with family permission, for grades 4-6. Must be administered to all students in grades 1-3 in 2023-2024. * Transfer students from a different district or community school in grades 1-3 must be given a screener within 30 days unless they were screened previously within the academic year. In grades 4-6, transfer students must be screened within 30 days of a parent or teacher request with parent permission. For Kindergarten transfer students, if they transfer after the district's screening window, they must be screened within 30 days.
