Kindergarten Reading Diagnostic Not earlier than the first day of July of the school year and not later than the 20th day of instruction of that school year. Used for Third Grade Reading Guarantee.					Kindergarten Tier 1 Dyslexia Screener A tier 1 dyslexia screening measure must be administered after January 1 of the school year the student is enrolled in kindergarten and prior to January 1 of the following school year.					
					Tier 2 Dyslexia Screener A Tier 2 dyslexia screener must be administered to each at-risk student, as determined by Tier 1 dyslexia screener results, who does not show progress toward attaining grade-level reading and writing skills by the sixth week after the student is identified as at risk by the Tier 1 screening results.					
Grade 1-3 Reading Diagnostic For students in grades 1-3 by September 30. Districts may use an approved dyslexia screener as their reading diagnostic. Used for Third Grade Reading Guarantee.										
Tier 1 Dyslexia Screener for Grades 1-6. By family request, or teacher request with family permission, for grades 4-6. Must be administered to all students in grades 1-3 in 2023-2024. * <i>Transfer students from a different district or community school in grades 1-3 must be given a screener within 30 days unless they were screened previously within the academic year. In grades 4-6, transfer students must be screened within 30 days of a parent or teacher request with parent permission. For Kindergarten transfer students, if they transfer after the district's screening window, they must be screened within 30 days.</i>
