MORE DETAILS:

The Ohio Statewide Family Engagement Center at The Ohio State University is excited to announce a grant-funded initiative with Hatching Results to deliver an extensive array of professional development sessions to Middle/Jr. High School Counselors across Ohio.

The professional development will develop or enhance evidence-based, comprehensive school counseling programs that improve academic, career/postsecondary, and social-emotional outcomes for students in participating middle schools/Jr. High Schools.

This professional development has been offered for more than **20 years** to school districts around the country with proven success.

We are excited to be able to offer this series to participating districts for free as a result of the Statewide Family Engagement Center grant and our partnership with Hatching Results.

REQUIREMENTS:

The professional development is a 4-year commitment. 6 PD days per school year (24 total) are grouped in three 2-day professional development days offered back-to-back. School counselors must commit to attending all 6-days of the PD each year.

Participating schools will be asked to measure the levels of Hope and School Belonging of their students at the beginning and end of each school year that they participate.

Schools that currently use Panorama to measure rates of School Belonging can continue to use that measure if it is offered at the beginning and end of the school year.

Schools should send all counselors from their counseling program to participate together. A school administrator from each participating school is required to attend the first day of training each school year in August.
