
FELOs at a Glance








Emotional Intelligence: Self-awareness




Recognizing your own emotions as they happen.

Emotional Intelligence: Self-management




Managing your emotions so they don't control your behavior.

Emotional Intelligence: Social Awareness




Understanding others' emotions and perspectives.

Parent Wise Feedback

- A method for teachers to give feedback to students that builds students' academic mindset, trust, and positive identity.

Start with Respect & Positive Regard

"Thanks for taking the time to talk today. I know you know your child best."

Share specific concern or observation



"This week, I noticed [name] has been walking out of class when we start writing."

Express high expectations and belief in success

Invite Collaboration



"Do you have any ideas about what's going on? One idea I had is ____; what do you think?"

End with Partnership



"Let's check in again. Thanks for talking this through. I really value your insight."

Start with Respect and Positive Regard

"First, I want to say how much I enjoy having Maya in class. She's curious, asks thoughtful questions, and contributes a lot to our discussions. I really appreciate the support you've given her at home — it's clear she has a strong foundation."



Share a Specific Concern or Observation

"I've noticed that over the past few weeks, some of her homework has been turned in late or only partly finished. That makes it harder for her to practice the skills we're working on in class."



Express High Expectations and Belief in Success

"I have high expectations for Maya because I know she's capable of meeting them. She's shown she can do excellent work, and I believe with some adjustments, she'll get right back on track."



Invite Collaboration

"I'd love to hear your perspective — have you noticed anything at home that might be making homework harder for her lately? Maybe together we can find strategies that will make it easier for her to stay on top of assignments."



End With Partnership

"My goal is to partner with you to help Maya succeed. Let's stay in touch about how she's doing, and please let me know if there are ways I can support her better from school. Together, I know we can help her thrive."


